## KINDERGARTEN SUGGESTED CLASSROOM SUPPLIES

Listed below are supplies that we suggest students bring to class this year. This suggested list has been compiled based on needs identified to support the Kindergarten curriculum.

Please note that the Constitution of the State of California requires that we provide a public education to you free of charge. Your right to a free education is for all school/educational activities, whether curricular or extracurricular, and whether you get a grade for the activity or class. Subject to certain exceptions, your right to a free public education means that we cannot require you or your family to purchase materials, supplies, equipment or uniforms for any school activity, nor can we require you or your family to pay security deposits for access, participation, materials, or equipment.

Therefore, while this list suggests that students bring a number of items, they are considered voluntary. No student will be restricted from participation if they are not sent to school.

- 2 pkg sof TWISTABLE Crayola Crayons (24 count or twistable)
- Expo Markers (2-4 black thin)
- 1 pallet of Crayola watercolors (8 colors)
- 1 pkg. Crayola Colored pencils (12-16 count)
- I pkg of WASHABLE Crayola Classic Markers (set of 10)
- Black Sharpie marker
- 5 inch scissors
- Bottle of Elmer's glue
- Copy papr- 2 reams
- Antibacterial Hand Soap or Sanitize
- 2 containers of Clorox Wipes
- 3 packs of Baby Wipes
- Pencils # 2 2 boxes of 12 or more, sharpened (Dixon or Ticonderoga brand)
- Girls ONLY Ziplock baggies with storage slider (quart size)
