SUGGESTED CLASSROOM SUPPLIES

Listed below are supplies that we suggest students bring to class this year. This suggested list has been compiled based on needs identified to support the Kindergarten curriculum.

Please note that the Constitution of the State of California requires that we provide a public education to you free of charge. Your right to a free education is for all school/educational activities, whether curricular or extracurricular, and whether you get a grade for the activity or class. Subject to certain exceptions, your right to a free public education means that we cannot require you or your family to purchase materials, supplies, equipment or uniforms for any school activity, nor can we require you or your family to pay security deposits for access, participation, materials, or equipment.

Therefore, while this list suggests that students bring a number of items, they are considered voluntary. No student will be restricted from participation if they are not sent to school.

Suggested Items:

- **4 Large Glue Sticks (Elmer)**
- **Eraser – White (Hi-Polymer Eraser, by Pentel)**
- **2 Packages Crayola Crayons – 16 count**
- **Expo Markers – Set of 4-12**
- **Black Sharpie Marker**
- **1 pallet of Crayola watercolors (8 colors)**
- **1 pkg. Crayola Colored Pencils (12-16 count)**
- **1 pkg. of Crayola Primary (Bold) Colored Markers (10 count)**
- **2 boxes of sharpened #2 Pencils (12 or more)(Dixon Ticonderoga brand)**
- **Copy Paper – 2 reams**
- **Kleenex – 2 boxes**
- **Antibacterial Hand Sanitizer (preferred over liquid soap)**
- **1 container of Clorox Wipes (Not Wet Ones or diaper wipes)**
- **Backpack (large enough for snack/lunch box, daily assignments, jackets etc.)
Please put your child's name on his/her backpack.**
- **Girls only – Ziplock baggies with storage slider (quart size)**
- **Boys only – Ziplock baggies with storage slider (gallon size)**
- **Snack/Lunch container that will fit in your child's backpack. Please put your child's name on all snack/lunch containers.**
- **Please provide a daily, nutritional, ready-to-eat snack (items your child can open/close by themselves) that can be eaten in 10-15 minutes.**
- **Please place an extra pair of underwear in a plastic bag for emergencies. Please label the bag with your child's name.**
- **A set of headphones to be returned at the end of the year. (Label with your child's name) No ear buds Optional:**
- **5 inch scissors**
- **Bottle of Elmer's white glue**
